How we help

- ▶ We award energy debt write-off grants to households who are struggling with their energy bills.
- ▶ We fund emergency fuel credit through our trusted partners.
- ▶ Our nationwide network of funded money and energy advice projects help people access the support and benefits they may be entitled to.

Our grants

The first step to getting financial help is always to understand what support is available to you.

If you are struggling with domestic gas and electricity debts owed to British Gas or other suppliers, you can apply for a grant from the Trust to clear your energy debt, up to £2,000.

We ask applicants to seek professional money advice before applying for one of our grants, as we will want to understand how your energy costs will be managed in the future. There is other criteria for the funds, so please check our website carefully before applying.
